Criteria for Nomination of Recipients for Montagu Trophy

A person nominated by a member Club to be considered for the Montagu trophy should fulfil the following criteria:

- a) have made a significant contribution to the Veteran Car club movement either at national or member club level (however, if primarily at state level, then the nominee should be at least known nationally so that other members can assess to some extent their contribution to the Veteran movement);
- b) be a current member of a member club (can not be awarded to a previous member or posthumously);
- c) the contribution to the movement must have been of significant duration (e.g. minimum of **10 years**);
- d) nominations should be accompanied by a testimonial from the member club. Testimonial not to exceed two typed pages;
- e) nominations must be received so that the nomination (and testimonial) can be circulated to member clubs with agenda items for AGM;
- f) nominations must be received by the Secretary/Treasurer before the 31 March for distribution to the clubs to ensure there is sufficient time to discuss the nominations before the AGM.

Accompanying testimonial should include details of:

- nature of contribution to the movement
- length of membership of member club(s)
- positions held (member club and/or national as appropriate);
- national and major club rallies/tours attended and/or contributed to;
- assistance to other members (restoration, parts, advice and support etc)

The trophy will be awarded for a period of 12 months. The Club, who nominates the successful applicant, is responsible to forward the trophy within 28 days of the AGM to the next recipient of the trophy at the sending clubs expense.
